

BYLAW NO. 751-92

A BYLAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A STREET

The Council of the Town of Kerrobert in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That a street or any portion thereof shall at the discretion of the Administrator be closed to all traffic, pedestrian only, heavy vehicles only, or by direction for the following purposes:
 - a). a parade or assembly of persons;
 - b). to facilitate the moving of a building, structure, machinery or other object;
 - c). to carry out street, water line or sewer line construction, repair or improvement, or any other work authorized pursuant to the Urban Municipality Act 1984;
 - d). for the construction, repair or improvement or demolition of a building or structure; or
 - e). for any other purpose considered necessary by resolution of the Council of the Town of Kerrobert.
2. That the Administrator provide regular reports to the Council of the Town of Kerrobert on all temporary street closures authorized.
3. Council shall cause every street that is closed pursuant to this bylaw to be marked with a sign indicating the street's closure and the hazards, if any, that would be encountered in its use.
4. Any person using a street closed to traffic pursuant to this bylaw does so at his own risk, has no right to recover damages in case of accident or injury and is liable for any damage or injury to the street resulting from such use.
5. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
