

# TOWN OF KERROBERT

## BYLAW NO. 1045-18

A Bylaw pertaining to Open-Air Fire Pits and Outdoor Fireplaces within the town limits and setting forth the conditions upon which fires are permitted.

1. That bylaw No. 1001-14 and all amendments be repealed and the following be enacted as follows:
2. In this Bylaw:
3. "Council" means the Council for the Town of Kerrobert;
  - a. "Fire Chief" means the Fire Chief for the Kerrobert Fire Department
  - b. "Fire Inspector" means a Fire Inspector for the Province of Saskatchewan;
  - c. "Open-air fire" means a fire built in the open air, for warmth, entertainment, or celebration, to burn charcoal or cut, seasoned wood;
  - d. "Peace Officer" means any member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, or any other police service responsible for the policing of the Town of Kerrobert or any person specifically appointed by the Town of Kerrobert or the Province of Saskatchewan to be a Police Officer, Constable, Special Constable or Auxiliary Constable; and
  - e. "Town" means the Town of Kerrobert
4. Fire Pits and Outdoor Fireplaces shall meet the following requirements:
5. The fire be contained in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of concrete, clay, brick or sheet metal with a minimum 18 gauge thickness;
6. The receptacle is covered with a heavy gauge metal screen with openings not exceeding 13 millimetres; and
7. The size of the fire box of any receptacle does not exceed .61 cubic metres.
8. The fuel used in the Fire Pits and Outdoor Fireplaces shall be only charcoal, cut seasoned wood or manufactured fire logs
9. No person shall cause, allow or permit the burning of the following materials in a Fire Pit or Outdoor Fireplace:
10. Waste, including rubbish, slimes, manure, treated or painted lumber, livestock or animal carcasses, tailings, garbage, garden refuse, or scrap;
11. Any material classified by the *authority having jurisdiction* as hazardous material or dangerous good; or

12. Any material that generates black smoke or an offensive odour when burned including, but not limited to, insulation from electrical wiring, rubber tires, asphalt shingles, hydrocarbons, plastics, and lumber treated with wood preservatives.
13. All Fire Pits or Outdoor Fireplaces shall be located a minimum of 3 metres from any combustible material, buildings, porch, deck, similar amenity space and property line.
14. All Fire Pits or Outdoor Fireplaces shall not be used on combustible decks or on apartment balconies.
15. All Fire Pits or Outdoor Fireplaces shall be situated on a non-combustible surface.
16. All Fire Pits or Outdoor Fireplaces shall be supervised by an adult so as to prevent the spread of fire.
17. If smoke from a Fire Pit or Outdoor Fireplace causes an unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another person's property, the fire shall be extinguished immediately.
18. Fire Pits or Outdoor Fireplaces shall not be used in windy conditions conducive to creating a fire spread.
19. Fire Pits or Outdoor Fireplaces shall be clear of overhangs such as tree branches, utility lines and structures.
20. Any person that uses a Fire Pit or Outdoor Fireplace shall ensure that a means of extinguishing the fire is readily accessible at all times while the fire is burning.
21. Where requested by the Fire Chief, a Fire Inspector, a Peace Officer or a Bylaw Enforcement Official, a person shall extinguish a fire in a Fire Pit or Outdoor Fireplace.
22. Notwithstanding any provisions of this Bylaw, the Fire Chief may declare a complete ban of any burning of any kind within the town limits.
23. The Fire Chief shall coordinate fire bans with the appropriate ministry of the Government of Saskatchewan.
24. No person shall ignite or allow any kind of fire when a complete ban on burning has been declared by the Fire Chief.
