## BYLAW No. 1055-20

## A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KERROBERT TO AMEND BYLAW No. 995-14 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Kerrobert, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 995-14 as follows:

- The Zoning District Map referred to in subsection 6.2, and which is attached to and forms part of
  the Zoning Bylaw, is amended by rezoning from C2 Highway Commercial District to MU –
  Mixed Use District, all of the following lands:
  - a. Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 18, 19, and 20, Block 23, Plan G162 Ext. 0:
  - b. Lots 1, 2, 3, and 42, Block 38, Plan G162 Ext. 0;
  - c. Lots 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, and 40, Block 22, Plan G162 Ext. 0; and
  - d. Lots 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, Block 5, Plan G64 Ext. 0.
  - e. Lots 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, and 41, Block 38, Plan G162 Ext. 0
  - f. Lots 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27, Block 23, Plan G162 Ext. 0

Said lands are shown within the bold dashed line on "Schedule 'A" which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

- 2. **Subsection 14.2 Mixed Use District MU, Discretionary Uses,** is amended to add the following new discretionary use after clause e):
  - f) Oilfield Supply and Services"
- 3. Subsection 14.3 Mixed Use District MU, Prohibited Uses, is amended to remove the following prohibited use:
  - o) Oilfield Supply and Services"
- 4. Subsection 14.9 Mixed Use District MU, Discretionary Use Evaluation Criteria is amended to include the following after clause b):
  - c) Specific Discretionary Use Evaluation Criteria for Oilfield Supply and Services:
    - Oilfield Supply and Service Establishments shall be located adjacent to major transportation corridors only;
    - The potential for noise, dust, smoke and other emissions causing pollution, nuisance or hazard to public safety to be effectively mitigated;
    - Council shall consider the proximity of existing or planned residential development in the area;
    - iv. Council shall consider surrounding land uses for applicability of site location for proposal; and,
    - v. Council shall consider the capacity of the existing storage compounds in the Town prior to rendering a decision."

This bylaw shall become effective on the date of approval by Council.
