

Employment Opportunity in Kerrobert, SK

Kerrobert is located in the West Central region of Saskatchewan approximately 65 km east of the Alberta border and 180 km west of Saskatoon. It has a strong agriculture base as well as being one of the main centers in the oil and gas industries in the province. Kerrobert has many attractions including the Kerrobert Museum and Cultural Centre in the old courthouse, professionally designed golf course, trout pond, interpretive nature trail, swimming and wading pools as well as the Poolside and Hillside parks.

Kerrobert EMS provides emergency services to a population of approximately 2500 residents in the town of Kerrobert and the surrounding area and covers 2699 km² resulting in approximately 261 calls per year.

Wage: PCP starting at \$29.909 in a 5 step range increasing annually to \$36.572
EMR starting at \$22.600 in a 3 step range increasing annually to \$24.210

We are currently hiring permanent casual EMRs and PCPs, temporary part time 0.75 FTE PCP positions and temporary part time 0.75 FTE EMR positions (168 hours in 6 week rotation based on 1948 hrs annually).

Shifts are 8 hours in facility at regular pay with 16 hours standby in a 5-5-4 rotation.

- Basic Life Support (BLS) Instructor Certificate, or required to obtain within 1 year of employment
- CMA Accredited Pre-Hospital Care Program at the PCP or EMR level
- Clean Driver's Abstract
- Health Care Provider Level C Certification (HCP-C)
- International Trauma Life Support (ITLS) - Basic
- Registered with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics as a Primary Care Paramedic with 2011 National Occupational Competency Profile (NOCP) standards
- Valid Class 4 drivers license

Other Information

- Must be able to respond to the ambulance within 10 minutes when on-call
- Preference for this position will be given to HSAS members in accordance with the terms and conditions of the SAHO/HSAS Collective Agreement.
- HSAS seniority within the Saskatchewan Health Authority will be considered under the Selection Criteria.

- The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) requires a criminal record check (CRC) from every potential SHA team member. The CRC must be dated within the past six (6) months and be satisfactory to the SHA.
- A vulnerable sector check (VSC) is required for individuals providing patient/resident/client care to vulnerable persons. Internal candidates may be required to provide a CRC and/or VSC during the recruitment and selection process.
