

ATTENTION PET OWNERS!



One of the biggest problems officers face is an alarming number of dogs and cats picked up without a license or I.D. tags.

Bylaw 1094-23, section 3 (a) states “Every owner of a dog/cat or dangerous animal to be registered with and obtain a license for it from the Town Office.”

Every owner of a dog or cat, six months old or older, shall no later than February 1st in each year obtain a license for the said dog or cat from the Town Office. The fine for a first offense of failure to license a dog/cat or dangerous animal is \$200.00 as per Bylaw 1094-23.

If your pet is lost, Animal Control wants to return it safely to you as soon as possible. Pets can't talk or carry a wallet. A license gives your pet a lifeline back to you!
