Our Sexual Health Clinic provides confidential, judgment-free, and inclusive care to support your sexual health and overall well-being. We are committed to creating a safe and welcoming environment for people of all genders, sexual orientations, and life stages.

What We Offer

- **Comprehensive Sexual Health Assessments:**

Holistic evaluations to support your physical, emotional, and relational well-being.

- **STI Testing and Treatment:** Confidential testing and treatment for common sexually transmitted infections, including chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, HIV, hepatitis B, hepatitis C, and HPV-related concerns.

- **Rapid & Self-Testing Options:** Access to quick testing options such as HIV self-test kits, and other rapid screening tools to support early detection.

- **Immunizations:** Access to recommended immunizations that support sexual health, including HPV, hepatitis A, and hepatitis B.

- **Contraception and Counseling:** Personalized guidance on birth control options, including pills, IUDs, injections, implants, and barrier methods.

- **Pregnancy Testing & Options Support:** Compassionate, unbiased education on available choices and next steps.

- **Referrals to other programs, including addiction programs and Hepatitis C/HIV positive care programs**
